### Hardship Fund Eligibility Application and Agreement for the 2008-2009 Season

The SF Titans VBC has established a hardship fund in an effort to provide limited financial assistance to possible players and their families who qualify for and comply with the requirements for participation in the HARDSHIP FUND program.

SF Titans VBC does not guarantee such assistance to anyone. SF Titans VBC does not guarantee that hardship funds will be available for all persons who apply and who may meet the minimum necessary requirements set forth below. SF Titans VBC is a not for profit organization that will make hardship funds available when possible based upon accumulated surplus, if any, created from its operations.

The parent of any child who wishes to participate in the SF Titans VBC 2008-2009 season may apply confidentially for hardship funds. The requirements and considerations are as follows:

1. At least one parent of the SF Titans VBC participant must register with Southern California Volleyball Association (SCVA) as a Chaperone;
2. A minimum of one-half the regular dues for the participant must be paid to SF Titans VBC as the "basic cost" of the program. Hardship funds will cover the remainder of the participant's dues. At least half of the basic cost must be paid on or before the second team practice for the participant. With the remaining balance of the basic cost due no later than 30 days thereafter.
3. If the basic cost is not paid in full on a timely basis, the participant will be benched and will not be able to play until such time the basic cost is paid in full.
4. One month's proof of household earnings will be required from the parent applicant, along with a letter describing the family situation and why they should be considered for hardship funds. The specific amount of hardship funds requested must also be set forth.
5. At least one letter of recommendation in favor of the participant receiving assistance, and attesting to their character qualities must also be submitted. This letter must be from someone other than a family member.
6. Full compliance to the SF Titans VBC Player/Parent Code of Ethics is required. Failure to comply may result in removal from the program.
7. Player participation in **all** fundraiser and regionals is **mandatory**.

All information submitted in accordance with this application for hardship funds will be kept strictly confidential by SF Titans VBC.

Hardship Funds will be disbursed in accordance with the best interests of the club.
